*Read Hebrews 7:1-10

- 1) What are some things in your life that seemed "permanent" to you that you now see will not last "forever"?

- 2) Why is it so important that Jesus is our high priest forever? What would be different if he were only our high priest for awhile?

- 3) What are the main things about Jesus that Melchizedek points to?
(Hint: You may need to re-read Hebrews 7:1-10 or take another look at it.)

- 4) What does it mean for you personally that Jesus is your priest? What does it mean for you personally that Jesus is your King? What is the difference between the two?

- 5) Why do you need to have Jesus' righteousness before you can have His peace?

- 6) Why was the writer of Hebrews so concerned to show that Jesus is a qualified high priest?

- 7) How does the encouragement that Jesus is with you wherever you go help you as you think about 2020?
