Growth Group Questions from Sunday, January 19 - Hebrews 7:23-28

*Read Hebrews 7:23-28

- 1) What are some things that some people turn to as they are looking for God, like the spiritualist seminars at the Manchester Community Library? What are some ways that we can use that longing for the divine to talk about Jesus?
- 2) In Hebrews 7:23-24 we see that one problem with priests is that they would die, but Jesus is our priest who lives forever. In 1 Corinthians 15 the Apostle Paul said that if Jesus was not raised our faith is in vain. How important is the resurrection in Jesus being your priest today?
- 3) What are some ways that you can remind yourself that Jesus is alive today?
- 4) How does Hebrews 7:25 show us the gospel? How could you use this verse to share the gospel with an unbeliever?
- 5) How could you use Hebrews 7:25 to encourage a believer who is struggling with feeling they have to earn God's forgiveness?
- 6) Why is it a lie that Jesus opens the door to salvation but that we have to finish His work in some way (fill in the blank with whatever the person or religion tells you)?
- 7) Which characteristic about Jesus mentioned in Hebrews 7:26 stands out to you: "holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, exalted above the heavens"? How does thinking about these attributes of Jesus help you love Him more?
